ORDER

In light of the expedited nature of the filings in this case, Petitioners request that the court order Respondents to file answers within 72 hours of service of the petition and that oral argument be set as soon as possible after receipt of Respondents' answers. The court grants, in part, Petitioners' Motion to Expedite and sets the following schedule.

- Respondents must file responses to the following filings no later than noon Tuesday, April 14, 2020:
 - Petitioners' Motion for Class Certification and
 - Petitioners' Verified Class Action Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus, including Petitioners' Memorandum of Points and Authorities.

- Petitioners may file a reply by 5 p.m. Tuesday, April 14, 2020.


- The court will hold oral argument by electronic means in this matter at 3 p.m. Wednesday, April 15, 2020.
 - The court will provide the parties with directions for oral argument by subsequent order.
 - The clerk of the appellate courts will provide notice with information about public viewing of the argument by electronic means.

- At oral argument, the parties should be prepared to address, among other issues, the following questions.
 - Does this court have jurisdiction over this matter?
 - Has service been affected on all necessary parties?
 - Are the named Petitioners appropriate representatives of those members of the potential class who reside in facilities other than those in which the Petitioners are housed?
 - Do the named Respondents have authority to provide each form of relief sought?
 - Are remedies short of release available?

The court will not consider any requests for extensions of this schedule.
